Sorana Păun Pop is an aeronautical inspector, specialized in air and space law, within the Romanian CAA. Her area of expertise is air navigation services. She deals mainly with matters related to the activities of the Romanian CAA as NSA (National Supervisory Authority) for safety, participating in various working groups to develop policies in the areas of NSA cooperation. One of her main focuses is the SES package. She is also in charge of developing regulations for air navigation services.

Sorana has served as Alternate Representative of Romania on the Council of the International Civil Aviation Organization where she offered advice on air law issues, actively participating in various legal and policy working groups, seminars etc. She was member of the legal team of Romania that participated in ICAO's Montreal Diplomatic Conference - The Modernization of the Rome Convention in 2009 and ICAO's Beijing Diplomatic Conference - Aviation Security Instruments.

Sorana teaches Air Law at Universitatea Politehnica Bucuresti. She has a PhD in air law and she holds an LLM from McGill Institute of Air and Space Law and a law degree from "Nicolae Titulescu" University.

Among others, Mrs. Păun Pop is an officer of the European Air Law Association (EALA) and serves on its Committee of Management.
