THE FUTURE OF MOBILITY BETWEEN INNOVATION AND SUSTAINABILITY

The aim of the PNRR (the Italian Recovery and Resiliant Plan) is to intervene on transport infrastructures with a view to environmental, social and economic sustainability. This, in order to create new modes of mobility starting from the existing ones. The Plan is in line with the proposals of the United Nations 2030 Agenda for Sustainable Development: all companies, including those in the transport sector, are required to adopt a proactive approach to sustainable development, through new business and management models and new technologies. In this context, although the Covid-19 pandemic has shed light on the vulnerabilities of the European single market and of the transport sector - which has been severely penalised by restrictive mobility measures to contain the contagion - the extraordinary circumstances that have arisen have provided an opportunity to understand the essentiality of the various forms of mobility. This led the sector to think more deeply about future investments and large-scale reforms.

The Conference examines all the initiatives that the transport sector is implementing in order to pursue the above objectives, which will influence the choices of maritime and air operators - also in light of the innovations to be introduced, for the airports, by the future National Airport Plan currently being drawn up - and of other modes of transport, such as rail, aimed at ensuring national connectivity and intermodality.
